

# Galaxy's Edge: Blackspire Outpost



*Star Wars: Galaxy's Edge* is a themed area inspired by the *Star Wars* franchise in Disneyland at the Disneyland Resort in Anaheim, California, and Disney's Hollywood Studios at the Walt Disney World Resort in Orlando, Florida.<sup>[2]</sup> It encompasses 14 acres (5.7 ha) at each park,<sup>[3]</sup> and is set in the village of Black Spire Outpost, on the remote frontier planet of *Batuu*, featuring attractions, shops, restaurants and entertainment based on elements of the fictional *Star Wars* universe.


The lands were announced on August 15, 2015,<sup>[4]</sup> and construction at both parks began on April 14, 2016.<sup>[5]</sup> The Disneyland version opened May 31, 2019, and Disney's Hollywood Studios' version opened August 29, 2019.<sup>[1]</sup> Walt Disney Imagineering executive Scott Trowbridge supervised development and construction at both parks.<sup>[6][7]</sup>


## Hondo Ohnaka
