Pandora: The World of Avatar is a themed area at Disney's Animal Kingdom theme park in Walt Disney World in Orlando, Florida. The area is based on James Cameron's film franchise. Construction began in 2014, with the area officially opening on May 27, 2017.

There will be another *Avatar* themed area at Disney's California Adventure in Anaheim, California. It will be based on *Avatar: The Way of Water* and *Avatar: Fire and Ash*. It is unclear if it will also be named *Pandora: The World of Avatar* in order to not confuse the parks in California and Florida.

Pandora, also known as **Eywa's Child** by the Na'vi (Na'vi name: ***Eywa'eveng***^[1]), is an Earth-like habitable extrasolar moon from the Alpha Centauri System, the closest star system to humanity's own Solar System. It is the fifth moon^[2] of the gas giant Polyphemus (previously named Crius), which orbits Alpha Centauri A at a distance of 1.2 AU (179.5 million kilometers).^[3] Pandora's sister moon is Cassandra, and they orbit Polyphemus with the other moons Hades, Dante, and Chaos, and nine others whose names are currently unknown. The names of both the moon and its mother planet are coined by humans in reference to figures in Greek mythology.

Pandora is located 4.423 light-years (26 trillion miles) from Earth.^[4] Its diameter is three-quarters of Earth's, and its mass is about half of Earth's. Despite being almost as large as Earth, Pandora is only a moon of a planet that has thirteen other moons. However, due to the smaller mass, Pandora's gravity is 20% less than Earth's, although its atmosphere is much denser than Earth's due to the presence of heavier gases. Depending on the position of the various moons, two or even three moons can be seen at once in the sky of Pandora. This causes solar eclipses to happen on almost a daily basis. Pandora and its sister moons also cast large black shadows on Polyphemus.

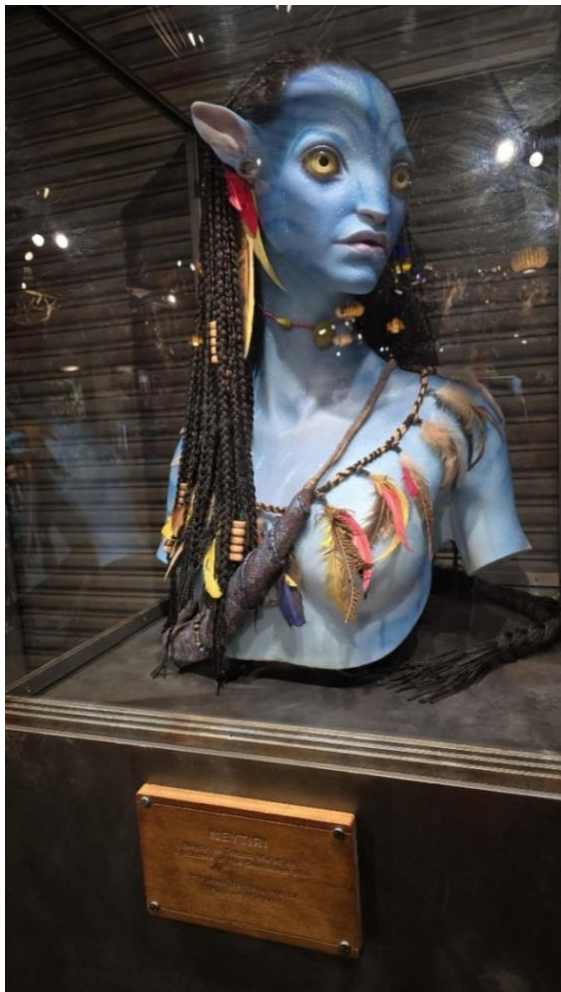
Avatar Flight of Passage



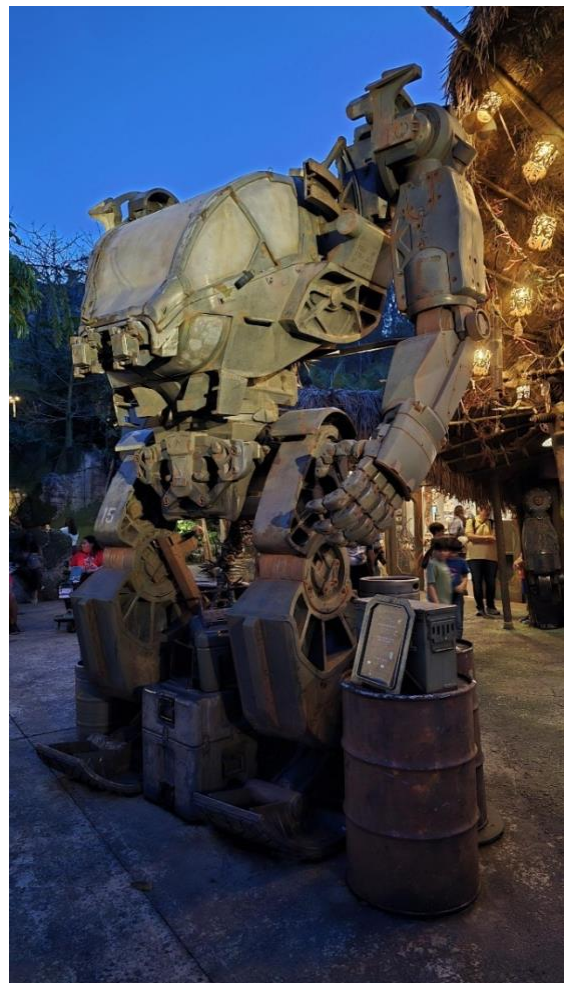
Na'vi River Journey



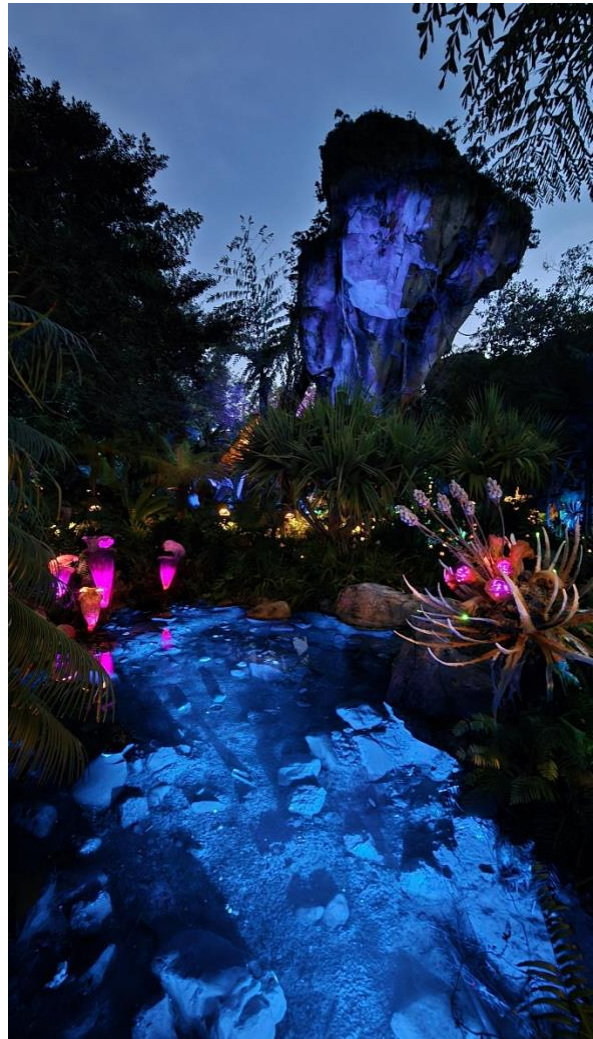

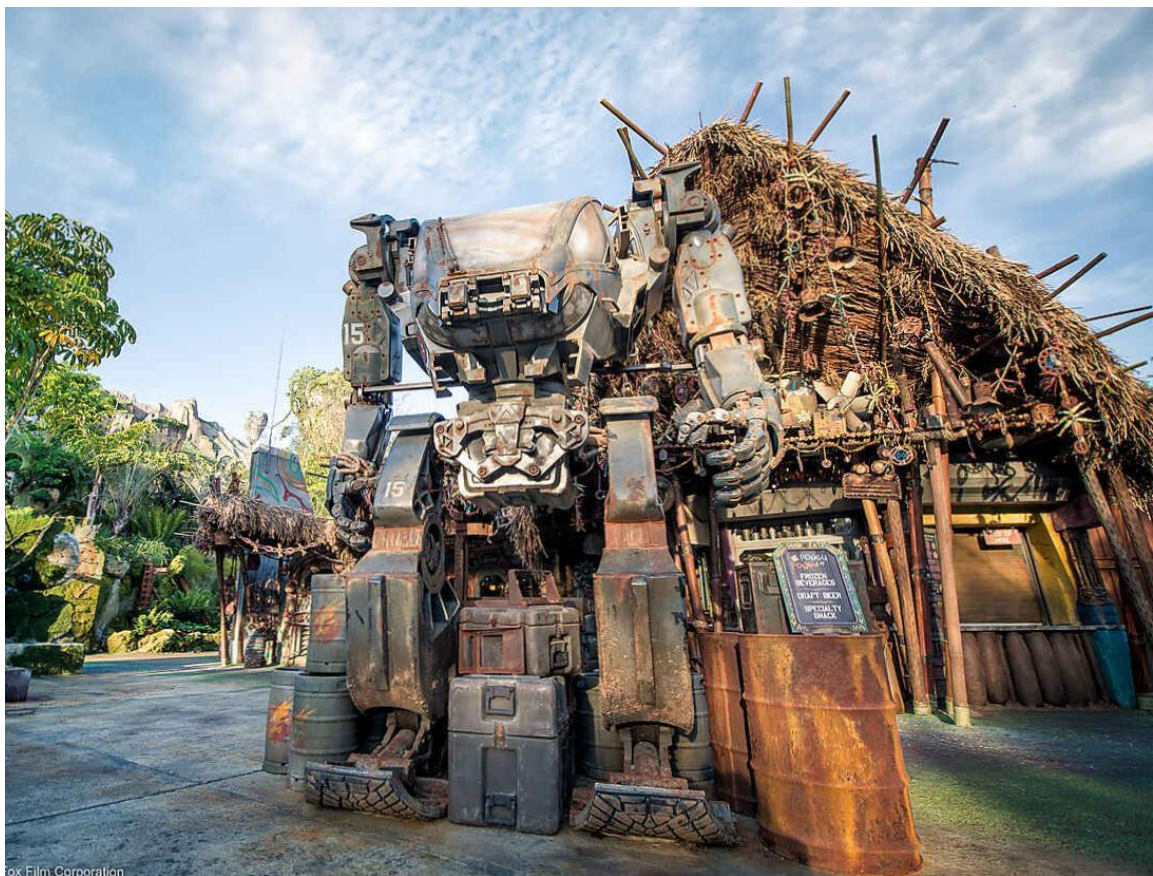
